Further to my letter in July I am writing to update you on the A42 J13 to M1 J23a maintenance work programme, which will start on site Monday 15 August 2016 and due to complete early November 2016. Please note that in preparation for this advance layby closures will be established on Sunday 14 August.

For the safety of the travelling public and our workforce, **the following closures will be in place between 15 and 29 August.**

A42 southbound closed between M1 J23a and the A42 J13 at Ashby-de-La-zouch. The road will be closed between 9pm and 6am Monday to Friday nights and closed from 8pm on a Saturday night. There will be no work taking place on Sunday nights.

Diversion routes are as follows:

Local diversion route will utilise the M1 then A512 at J23 back to the A42 at J13. There will also be a non-motorway traffic diversion route signed along the A453. Traffic travelling longer distance will be advised to follow the M1 to J21 then M69.

Please note that *no work will be carried out over the August bank holiday weekend* ie no closures on Friday 26th, Saturday 27th, Sunday 28th or Monday 29th.

These closures have been published on the Highways England website and the diversion routes will be clearly signed. The planned closures may be cancelled or extended in the event of inclement weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

Further updates

We would also like to provide you with advanced notification of our planned full weekend closures of the southbound carriageway:

- 9pm on Friday 16th September through to 6am Monday 19th
- 9pm on Friday 30th September through to 6am Monday 3rd October
